PERSONAL SURETY DEPOSIT \$1,200 U.S.

Due to F-1 restrictions, upon matriculation international students acquire greater financial risk than domestic students. The Personal Surety Deposit is a proactive measure to fund the "unexpected" expenses that many of our international students face during their time at Oakwood.

This initial, per family, one-time Personal Surety Deposit for incoming international students must be received in the Admissions Office before a Certificate of Eligibility for Non-Immigrant Student Status (I-20) can be issued.

The Personal Surety Deposit It is refundable upon written request to the Office of Student Accounts to use at the Student's discretion after either:

- a) the student experiences financial hardship due to loss of support or other unexpected circumstances;
- **b**) the student has completed one full academic year of study;
- c) the student has completed his or her full program of study and has returned home.
