GENERAL STUDIES

Not every college student has a clear path from start to finish in pursuing a degree. Many change majors or take a variety of classes not required for a particular major. In some cases, students are unable to complete special requirements for a particular major. As a result, they may accumulate a lot of college credits and yet still have no clear prospective of earning a college degree. These students often never finish school and just go on with life — without that all-important degree. To address this need, Oakwood University has developed its Bachelor of Science in General Studies program.



General Studies Requirements

Total General Education Requirements:	45 hours
Humanities	15 semester hours
Natural Science & Math	9 semester hours
Social Sciences	9 semester hours
Computer & Health	5 semester hours
Religion	6 semester hours

Completion of 83 hours in general studies. This includes

- The satisfactory completion of two upper division writing-emphasis courses of at least 2 hours each.
- Satisfactory completion of 40 semester hours of upper division level course work.
- Completion of a minimum of 32 hours at Oakwood University.

Total General Education requirements:	45 semester hours
Total General Studies requirement:	83 semester hours
Total Graduation requirements:	128 semester hours
