Why Plan Ahead?

Planning ahead ensures you have time to complete your FAFSA accurately, gather required documents, and resolve any issues before deadlines.

Submitting early gives you access to the maximum amount of financial aid available, including limited grants and scholarships that are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
